He is also a retired/reserve Brazilian police captain and instructor with over 16 years of experience in law enforcement. His interest in police training began in 2014, following a visit to the ALERRT Center, which introduced him to the concept of tactical research. This led him to pursue a master’s degree in Psychology in 2021. During the program, his position within the police department enabled him to conduct several practice-driven research projects focused on improving training and policing. His work has contributed to major reforms in the department’s self-defense syllabus and training methods. He currently lives in Texas, where he is pursuing a Ph.D. in Criminal Justice at Texas State University. His research centers on police use-of-force training and tactics.
